### Timeline

February 2011: Official opening

May 2012: All services available

### Support and Treatment

- Mother and Child Care (prenatal care, childbirth care, postnatal care)
- Consultation bureau for children until age 5
- Vaccination programme
- Access to General Practitioners
- First Aid care
- HIV/TB treatment
- Education and providing information in the neighborhood, schools and factories
- Laboratory investigations
- Issue of medications

### Eligible Persons

Vulnerable persons in society:

*Mothers and children, elderly, persons with a disability or HIV, under educated persons*

Services are free of charge for people with a monthly income less than € 13 and for pregnant women, children under the age of 5 and HIV patients.



### Number of People Reached per Year

In 2019: more than 60.000 consultations

### Impact of the Support

People at a disadvantage in society have access to sufficient healthcare.

### Expected Results

- Decrease in maternal and infant mortality rates for children below 5 years of age.
- Increase of fully vaccinated children
- Fewer HIV infections
- Healthy and productive population
